Morning School Drop Off:

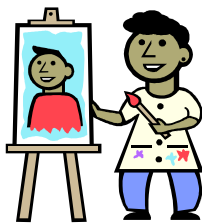
If you arrive after 7:45 a.m. and want to walk your child into the West Hall, pull into a designated parking space. Please do not block the drive and/or your leave your car running.
