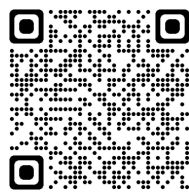

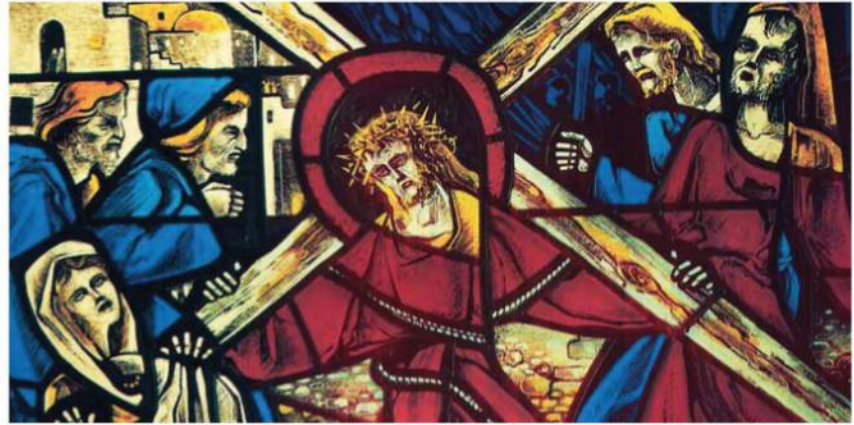
EUCCHARISTIC MIRACLES

Was Nourished Only By The Eucharist For Over 13 Years

BLESSED ALEXANDRINA MARIA DA COSTA

PORTUGAL, 1904-1955

Alexandrina remained paralyzed at age 21 from a dramatic incident in which she fled from the threat of violence. She did not permit herself to be overcome by sadness and by loneliness, but thought: "Jesus, You are a prisoner in the tabernacle as I am here on my bed, so that we can keep company". Following the physical sufferings from the paralysis, mystical sufferings were added: for four years, every Friday she saw the sorrows of the Passion, and after this period, for another 13 years until her death she was nourished only by the Eucharist. Her life became a continuous prayer for the conversion of sinners.

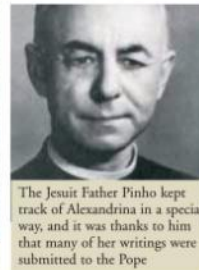
On her tomb are the words she wished to be placed there: "Sinners, if the ashes of my body can be useful for your salvation, draw near to them, pass above them, and trample on them until they vanish. But sin no more; do not offend our Jesus any longer!"

Alexandrina Maria was born in Balasar, Portugal on March 30, 1904. At age 14, in order to escape an attack by three men and to maintain her purity, she jumped from the window, but did not escape without suffering injury. The consequences were terrible, if not immediate. In fact, several years later, she became bedridden from a progressively increasing paralysis, from which she suffered for the remaining 30 years of her life. Yet, she did not despair, but entrusted herself to Jesus with these words: "As you are a prisoner in the tabernacle and I am a prisoner on my bed for doing Your will, so we can keep ourselves company". As a result, she began to live through ever more powerful mystical experiences, and from Friday, October 3, 1938 until March 24, 1942, for up to 182 times, she relived the sufferings of the Passion. Beginning in 1942 until her death, Alexandrina was fed only by the Eucharist, and

during a period of convalescence at the Foce del Douro Hospital near Oporto, for forty days and forty nights she was under supervision by several doctors in her absolute fast and her condition of *anuria* (absence of urine). After 10 long years of paralysis which she had offered as Eucharistic reparation for the conversion of sinners, on July 30, 1935, Jesus appeared to her saying: "I have put you in the world so that you may draw life only from Me, to bear witness to the world how precious the Eucharist is. [...]"

"The strongest chain that keeps souls in bondage with Satan is the flesh and the sins of impurity. Never has there been such a spread of vices, wickedness and crimes as there is today! Never has there been so much sin [...] The Eucharist - My Body and Blood - Behold, the

Eucharist is the salvation of the world." Mary also appeared to her on September 12, 1949, with the Rosary in her hand, saying to her "The world is in agony and is dying in sin. My desire is for prayer, my desire is for penance. I have protected with this, my Rosary, all those whom I love and the whole world." On October 13, 1955, the anniversary of the last apparition of the Blessed Mother at Fatima, Alexandrina was heard exclaiming: "I am happy, for I am on my way to heaven." She died at 7:30 in the evening on that very day.

LOVE YOUR NEIGHBOR

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

It gives me great joy to write to you once more. With the coming Thanksgiving holiday, it is a good time to reflect on our interactions with family and friends. The Thanksgiving gatherings give us ample opportunity to become more like Jesus – loving, merciful, and forgiving.

As we prepare for the holiday this week, let us recall that we are all made in the likeness of God. Even, difficult people are made in the image and likeness of God. Consequently, we are called to find Jesus in everyone. We are called to find Jesus in each other especially when we gather. We are to love God by loving the person right in front of us. Love those in the room with you. Yes, I agree. This is easier said than done.

The challenge is to make those around you feel the love of God. They should feel love, mercy, and forgiveness from us, the Christians in the room. The challenge is to really listen to the person next to you. Allow the quiet ones to speak without interruption. Don't always have a comeback or tell a bigger and better story. Ask questions which show that you are interested in hearing more. Be ready to discuss what you are thankful to God for. Don't forget to pray to God. Ask him to give you a loving, merciful, and forgiving presence for the occasion. Put your cellphone away for maximum results.

Our presence is a gift from God. It is a grace from God. This is something we all have. When we give our full attention to others, we fulfill our call from Jesus to love our neighbor. We bring the presence of Jesus when we listen again to Grandpa's old stories. We bring Jesus when we listen to one of the kids tell us what they are thankful for. We bring Jesus when we listen to a brother-in-law go on and on about his, latest and greatest, big idea.

Let us turn our attention to Holy Scripture. Jesus invites us to mercy in Luke Chapter 6:

“Be merciful, just as [also] your Father is merciful. Stop judging and you will not be judged. Stop condemning and you will not be condemned. Forgive and you will be forgiven. Give and gifts will be given to you; a good measure, packed together, shaken down, and overflowing, will be poured into your lap. For the measure with which you measure will in return be measured out to you.” (Luke 6:36–38) “This invitation to mercy contains a promise of happiness. It's not easy to live out, but if you live it with God's help, you will be fulfilled, ‘good measure, ... running over.’ “ (Luke 6:38) (Philippe, Trusting God, p. 41)

With the help of the Holy Spirit, we can bring gratitude to God and the love of Jesus into our Thanksgiving celebrations! My good and holy friends, may you seek Christ. May you find Christ. May you love Christ. Amen!

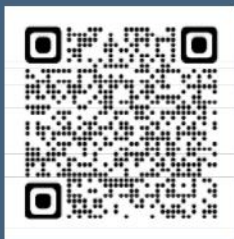

Ten Good Reasons to go to Mas #8 : We know we make mistakes.

Do you pay attention to what we all do at the very beginning of Mass? Father greets us and might have a thought to share about the Mass and what we are celebrating that particular Sunday. After we open Mass with the Sign of the Cross, he says "let us confess our sins and so prepare ourselves to celebrate these sacred mysteries." We respond by saying "I confess to Almighty God and to you my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned....." Lord have mercy. Christ have mercy. Lord have mercy. What have we just done? We have admitted to God and to our brothers and sisters in Christ that we have made mistakes. We admit that we made mistakes that we know were not in keeping with God's will for each of us. Because our Catholic faith imparts in our hearts a great love for what we are about to celebrate, we desire to rid ourselves of the "clutter" of our lives that can keep us from experiencing the mystery of the Eucharist. We all need this. Does this replace going to the Sacrament of Reconciliation.....NO. The Penitential Rite is just what I said it is.....uncluttering our spiritual selves. In so doing, we can be assured that God loves us and continues to extend to each of us an invitation to participate in the Paschal Mystery, re-presented at each and every Mass. Serious sin is not what we are talking about here. That requires sacramental cleansing. The Penitential Rite strengthens us in our commitment to live moral lives so we can experience the fullness of all God has and does for each of us. - Deacon John

Dear Pastor,

I am pleased to announce that our next training program for Nullity Case Sponsors will be held in Spring 2024 in both English and Spanish¹. This training is for all clergy and any other lay people personally selected by the Pastor. In the past, we have found that those who have been through the Nullity Process themselves often make superb Case Sponsors. We encourage every parish to have as many trained Nullity Case Sponsors as is possible; so send as many individuals as you deem necessary to assist you. As always, priests and deacons are welcome to attend. Registration can be found on our website www.archgh.org/tribunal. All participants (including Priests and deacons) must register due to limited space.

Lay people must be chosen carefully by the pastor and possess certain requisite qualities. Namely, they must understand and adhere to the teachings of the Church, especially with regard to the teachings on marriage. They must be in good standing with the Church; be discrete and non-judgmental; have common sense and critical thinking skills; be patient and have good communication skills; and have ample time to serve in this capacity. To qualify to serve as a Nullity Case Sponsor, one must complete all 36 hours of training. For Deacons, this training can be applied toward their required continuing education hours.

Enclosed is a description and schedule of the courses offered as well as registration information.
